Allocation of Funds in 2018

Each year, the Diocese of Tucson assesses its financial resources, the needs of parishioners and its ability to respond effectively and with compassion. This illustration is an overview of how Appeal contributions will be distributed:

\$2,900,000 for Diocesan Ministries

Ministries receiving funding by gifts to the ACA include Seminarian Education, Vocations, Religious Education, Catholic Schools, Office of the Permanent Diaconate, Office of Religious Women, Office of Human Life and Dignity, Office of the Tribunal, Pastoral Care Ministry, Archives Office, and the Bishop's Office.
